

The IFIA President's Message occasion of the 2nd IIDC, Bangkok

I cordially greet the participants and the visitors of the 2nd International Inventors' Day Convention in Bangkok in the name of the IFIA which has members from 86 countries. This world inventor's federation is forty years old. The celebration of its birthday by IFIA Jubilee Year started here occasion of the First International Inventors' Day Convention in 2008. This celebration remains unforgettable for ever.

The IFIA decided that the 2nd International Inventors' Day Convention be again organized in Bangkok together the Thai Inventors' Day. What were the motives of this decision? I will show our two motives which lead us to bring this decision.

Innovation will fall victim to the present global economical crisis. This is a very bad prospect for the world. Let me remind you to my presidential motto: "There is no prosperity without innovation and there is no innovation without inventions and no inventions without inventors."

The most important tool against the economical crisis is the governmental support of innovation. The IFIA think, that the National Research Council of Thailand which organized the First IIDC is a well managed efficient organization for promote the innovation. The NRCT is worthy of the example how to work for the prosperity. The organization of the 2nd International Inventors' Day Convention would serve to fellow their good example for other countries. This was one of our motives. The second one a little bit more important for us.

As you seen the essential element of the prosperity is the inventor who can able to create technical solutions. Unfortunately the social appreciation of the inventors was generally decreased. In this situation that is very important to show a great inventor prominent person to the whole world who will become symbol for everybody. This prominent person would be His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej who is successful multiple inventor and photographer, painter, composer and writer, who is a Renaissance type creator than Leonardo da Vinci was before several centuries.

His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej is called "The Father of Thailand Invention" before and now the IFIA proclaims him "The Father of World Invention".
