Plus, the applicant should attach their curriculum vitae, an English translation of the company statutes, and a photo of their passport to the submitted documents and send them to [standard@ifia.com](mailto:standard@ifia.com)
2. After the evaluations, IFIA issues the standard for the innovation.
3. The validity period of this standard is 24 months.
4. An innovation can apply for the standard certificate only once. If the jury did not accept the submission for whatever reason, the innovator must accept it.
5. The evaluation takes two to four weeks, and IFIA will inform the applicant through email.
6. Receiving this standard does not give a green light for the production of the invention. To produce the invention, it is necessary to operate under the laws of the country of production.
7. The person who has their name mentioned on this form fully understands English and accepts all the responsibilities of filling out this form.
8. The applicant must peruse all the terms and conditions, and requesting this application means accepting them.
